Actress, singer and philanthropist Alisa Reyes reprises her role as LaCienega Boulevardez in Disney+'s "The Proud Family: Louder and Prouder," the long-anticipated revival of the groundbreaking animated series "The Proud Family."

Reyes began her professional career as an actress at the age of seven and is best known for her regular series role on "All That," which she recently reprised in the series reboot. She also starred in "One World," playing a Cuban-born entrepreneur, and received a YoungStar Award for her performance. Her additional credits include "Break Even," "Without a Trace," "Strong Medicine," "Passions," "The Bold and the Beautiful," "NYPD Blue," "ER," "Boston Public," "Six Feet Under" and "American Family." In 2020, she, alongside Scott Barber and Bill Parks, produced "The Orange Years: The Nickelodeon Story."

In 2019, she released her latest single "Back & Forth," featuring and produced by Linnie King Twigg and mixed/mastered by DJ EVIL DEE. Prior to her solo music career, she was in "3G's," a girls group that was signed with Hollywood Records.

She is involved with American Cancer Society, Kids with a Cause, Green Means Go, Ronald McDonald House, Make a Wish, Hope for Firefighters, United Nations, Children's Hospital and National Wildlife Federation, as well as The Hollywood Knights celebrity charity basketball league. She is also a board member for the nonprofit dance company, California Dance Institute.
