Ana Ortiz stars as Jen in the brand-new season of the hit series "Goosebumps," inspired by R.L. Stine's worldwide bestselling books.

Ortiz broke out as Hilda Suarez in ABC's hit comedy "Ugly Betty," earning both American Latino Media Arts and Imagen Awards in the Best Supporting Actress category for her portrayal as Betty's sassy older sister. Along with her personal recognition, the show won a 2007 Emmy® Award for Outstanding Casting for a Comedy Series; two Golden Globe Awards, including Best Television Series – Comedy or Musical; and another 39 wins and 66 nominations.

Her additional television credits include roles as A.D.A. Holly Raines on ABC's acclaimed "Boston Legal," Anna in the FX series "Over There," and appearances on ABC's "A.U.S.A" and "Kristin," as well as pilots "True Blue" and "Outnumbered."

Ortiz starred in Marc Cherry's "Devious Maids" and had a recurring role on "The Mindy Project." She also appeared alongside Viola Davis in Shonda Rhimes' "How to Get Away with Murder" and opposite Anthony Anderson in ABC's hit series "black-ish."

Most recently, Ortiz was seen as a series regular on the popular Hulu show "Love, Victor." Prior to that, she starred in the ABC series "Whiskey Cavalier," alongside Scott Foley and Lauren Cohan.

Ortiz was born in New York and currently resides in Los Angeles.
