



Barry Rosenbush

Executive Producer

Barry Rosenbush is an Emmy® Award-winning executive producer of Disney Channel's smash hit movies "High School Musical," "High School Musical 2" and "High School Musical 3," and is currently serving as executive producer for "High School Musical: The Musical: The Series," a reinvented take on the movies, for Disney+.

A graduate of New York University's Film School, Rosenbush began as a production assistant for Woody Allen on the film "Annie Hall," followed by "Rocky" and "Raging Bull." He later worked with Academy Award-winning "Rocky" producer Gene Kirkwood and Howard Koch, Jr. and shepherded many films, including "Idolmaker," "Pope of Greenwich Village," "Gorky Park" and "Ironweed."

In 1986, Rosenbush started his own production company, where he worked on a number of diverse features, including "The Fisher King," "Cold Sassy Tree" and "American Pastime," as well as television projects with ABC and TNT.

In 1990 Rosenbush formed a partnership with Bill Borden and together they began developing feature films and television movies, including the Disney Channel Original Movie "Tiger Cruise," starring Bill Pullman and Hayden Panettiere, which they executive-produced. Rosenbush has served as a production executive on "Scary Movie 2," as well as the HBO movie "And Starring Pancho Villa as Himself."

He also served as the executive producer on a series of foreign remakes of "High School Musical" in China, Argentina and Mexico.

Rosenbush currently resides in Las Vegas with his wife Cynthia.
