



### **BIOGRAPHY**

#### **Brandy Norwood** "Cinderella"

Multi-platinum, GRAMMY-winning singer, songwriter, producer, and actress Brandy is one of the most influential artists in pop culture history. She emerged as a teenage sensation in the '90s with her 4x-platinum self-titled debut album, the hit sitcom *Moesha*, and her starring role in Disney's television adaptation of "Rodgers & Hammerstein's Cinderella".

Adoringly known as "The Vocal Bible," her decades-long career has proven she deserves the title. With a singular voice that swells from subdued to powerful, she has captivated audiences since 1994. Her subsequent projects — from 1998's 16x-platinum *Never Say Never*, featuring the GRAMMY®-winning single "The Boy Is Mine," to 2002's *Full Moon*, 2020's *b7*, and 2023's *Christmas with Brandy* — have cemented her status as a genre-defining icon.

As an actress, Brandy continues to showcase her versatility in projects such as Disney's "Descendants: The Rise of Red," streaming on Disney+, Netflix's "Best. Christmas. Ever!", the Lifetime holiday film "Christmas Everyday," and her reprised role as the iconic Karla Wilson in 2025's "I Know What You Did Last Summer."

Her versatility also extends to live theater. In 2015, she made her Broadway debut as 'Roxie Hart' in the Tony Award-winning musical "Chicago."

Her image and voice have been immortalized through seven dolls produced by Mattel® in the 1990s and, in 2024, through an additional Disney Descendants doll created in her likeness, underscoring her lasting cultural reach.

In 2025, Brandy reunited with Monica for the sold-out North American fall run of *The Boy Is Mine* Tour, bringing their legacy full circle on stage.

In 2026, Brandy was bestowed with the Black Music Icon Award from the Recording Academy and the Black Music Collective. Later that same year, Brandy's memoir, *PHASES*, debuted at No. 1 on *The New York Times* Best Seller list (including its accompanying audiobook) and was



described as “the result of countless hours of reflection, work, and healing.” Additionally, in 2026, Brandy was honored with a star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame, further cementing her cultural impact.

Brandy has sold more than 40 million records worldwide, making her one of the best-selling female artists of all time.
