Carlo Cresto Dina is an Italian producer. During his career, he worked for important production companies in Italy and London, producing films by authors such as Ken Loach, Abbas Kiarostami, Emir Kusturica, Ermanno Olmi and Fernando Trueba. In 2009, he founded tempesta, which has quickly gained a reputation for discovering and nourishing European film talents. "Happy Lazzaro" (2018) and "The Wonders" (2014), directed by Alice Rohrwacher and produced by tempesta, won the Best Screenplay Award and the Grand Prix at the Cannes Film Festival, respectively. tempesta produced all of Leonardo Di Costanzo's feature films, including "Ariaferma" (2021), which has been nominated for Film of the Year in Italy. tempesta U.K., the company's English branch, produced "Wildfire" (2020), Cathy Brady's debut feature, which was acclaimed at Toronto Film Festival.
