Born in Mexico City, Christian Tappan, lived most of his childhood and teen years in Colombia, where he entered the acting world as a child, participating in TV ads and integrating the children's band "Los Monachos", managed by Maria Angelica Jaramillo. After participating in musicals and plays in his teens, he joined the cast of Colombian series and soap operas of the 1990s in "Padres e Hijos", "O Todos en la Cama", "La Otra Raya del Tigre" and "Copas Amargas". In 1996, he returned to Mexico to further his training at CEFAC (TV Azteca Acting Training Center) and then continued to develop his career in both countries, with various roles in television productions. Among others, he joined the cast of "No Renuncies", "Salomé", "Amor Descarado", "Decisiones", "Zorro: la Espada y la Rosa" and "Sin Senos no Hay Paraíso". In 2008, he played Poncho AKA "Cheeseball", in the series "Vecinos", a character that marked him before the public and continues to identify him to this day. Four years later, he joined the cast of the renowned series Pablo Escobar, "The Drug Lord", for which he won the India Catalina 's award for Best Supporting Actor for his acting as Gustavo Gaviria. The following year, he received the same distinction for his participation in the series "La Promesa". In recent years, he has played various roles in productions such as "Narcos", "La Hermandad", "Paraíso Travel", "Wild District", "María Magdalena", "Queen of the South" and "The Heist of the Century". On the big screen, he made his debut in 2013, in the film "El Control", "Antes del Fuego", "Que Viva la Música", "La Semilla del Silencio", "La Boda de Valentina" and "Los Días de la Ballena" are other film works in which he has participated.
