Dan Shotz

Executive Producer

Dan Shotz is currently the executive producer of the new adaptation of the popular book series "Percy Jackson & the Olympians" for Disney+. With the second season airing this December and an early renewal for a third season, "Percy Jackson and the Olympians" broke records for Disney Branded Television, becoming its most-watched series in the platform's history. Season One went on to win eight Children's and Family Emmy Awards, including Best Series.

Shotz was recently the executive producer of the critically acclaimed series "The Old Man," starring Jeff Bridges and John Lithgow, for FX/HULU. Before "The Old Man," Shotz wrote and executive-produced "See" for Apple TV+ and the STARZ series "Black Sails," which won three Primetime Emmy Awards. In 2019, Shotz and his producing partner, Jonathan E. Steinberg, signed a multi-year overall deal with 20th Television/Walt Disney Co., where their production company, Quaker Moving Pictures, is now based. Prior to that, Shotz was a partner with director Jon Turteltaub at Junction Entertainment, the company responsible for the "National Treasure" film franchise. While at Junction Entertainment, Shotz developed and produced the series "Common Law" for the USA Network as well as "Harper's Island" and fan-favorite "Jericho" for CBS Television.

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
