David Lowery is the director, producer, and writer of “An Almost Christmas Story,” an animated short that follows Moon, a curious young owl who unexpectedly finds himself stuck in a Christmas tree destined for Rockefeller Plaza.

“An Almost Christmas Story” is a CG animated short inspired by traditional stop motion animation, meant to evoke cardboard art. The short marks the latest entry in producer Alfonso Cuarón’s series of holiday shorts, following “Le Pupille” and “The Shepherd.”

Lowery is an acclaimed filmmaker with a diverse filmography spanning a wide range of genres, characterized primarily by a singular sense of heightened naturalism.

Upcoming, Lowery is in post-production on A24’s highly anticipated epic pop melodrama “Mother Mary,” starring Anne Hathaway and Michaela Coel. With music by Charli XCX and Jack Antonoff, the film follows the relationship between a fictional popstar (Hathaway) and an iconic fashion designer (Coel).

Lowery’s prior work includes “A Ghost Story,” “Pete’s Dragon,” “Ain’t Them Bodies Saints,” “Peter Pan & Wendy,” “Pioneer,” “St. Nick,” “The Old Man & The Gun” and National Board of Review winner “The Green Knight.”
