Since ancient times in Motunui, garland head dresses have been used to mark special occasions, special people and special objects. Moana's flower crown is used when she's a 'chief in training'. Now, you can make one for yourself to wear as you watch Moana save her tribe.

# What you'll need

Leaves from the garden or craft store (stems on)
Flowers from the garden or craft store (stems on)
Floral Tape
Scissors
Craft wire
Vine wire
A parent to assist

## Step 1

Let's start with the crown. Measure the wire around your head and tape the ends together with the floral tape, then set aside.

### Step 2

Next, let's create 4-6 mini bunches of leaves and flowers, wrapping the stems together with floral tape, wrap the entire length of the stems.

### Step 3

Now let's put them together. Starting from the centre of the crown, use craft wire and floral tape to wrap the first bunch of stems around the crown. Use floral tape to cover all wires. Continue to attach flowers until your crown is complete!
