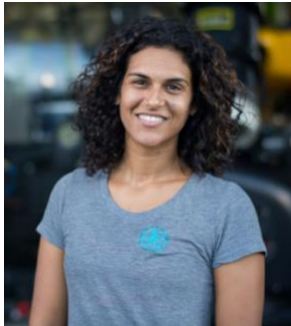




WELCOME TO EARTH

Diva Amon is a marine biologist focused on the little-known habitats and animals of the deep ocean and how our actions impact them. She works at the nexus of science, policy and communication with a deep desire to see stewardship measures applied to the deep ocean as well as the engagement of a broader group of global stakeholders toward this effort.

Dr. Amon has participated in research cruises around the world, exploring previously unknown deep-sea habitats from Antarctica to the Marianas Trench. During her explorations, she has ventured 2.6 kilometers below the ocean surface. She has spoken at the United Nations, the World Economic Forum and the Nobel Prize organization, as well as filmed with National Geographic, BBC and CNN,

to name just a few.

Dr. Amon is a 2020 National Geographic Emerging Explorer, a Pew-Bertarelli Ocean Ambassador and a World Economic Forum Friend of Ocean Action. She is also a founder and director of SpeSeas, an NGO dedicated to marine science, education and advocacy in her home country of Trinidad and Tobago.
