Dayna Kalins Bochco, President of Steven Bochco Productions, oversees the development, distribution and marketing of new and current television series as well as business affairs and general administration of the company.

Since its inception, Kalins Bochco has overseen all aspects of Steven Bochco Production series, including the Emmy Award winning, "NYPD Blue" for its entire twelve year run on ABC. Her producer credits include "Philly," "City of Angels," "Blind Justice," "Over There" and "Raising the Bar" and the upcoming "Doogie Kamealoha, M.D."

Prior to joining Steven Bochco Productions, Kalins Bochco was Executive Vice President of Creative Affairs and Executive Vice President of Business Affairs at Twentieth Century Fox Television.

Kalins Bochco, currently sits on the California Coastal Commission, serving as its chair from 2016 - 2019. She also served on the State Coastal Conservancy. Bochco has been an active member of NRDC for many years and is a past co-chairperson of the LA Leadership Council. She has previously served on the board of Heal the Bay and the Santa Monica Bay Restoration Commission. Her main interest is on California ocean and water issues. Over the years she has worked for legislation and policies to clean up the ports of Los Angeles and Long Beach, rid California of plastic bags, and promote water conservation.

Kalins Bochco graduated from the University of California, Berkeley and has a Juris Doctor degree from Loyola Law School.
