"Ricky"

Joshua Bassett plays the lead role of "Ricky" on "High School Musical: The Musical: The Series." He co-wrote and performed "Just For a Moment" with Olivia Rodrigo for season one received more than one million streams on Spotify in the first week it was released.

Bassett's single with Warner Records, "Lie Lie Lie," debuted at No. 33 on the Billboard Emerging Artists chart and opened at No. 25 on Billboard's Bubbling Under Hot 100 chart. In early 2021, he unveiled his self-titled debut EP, including songs like "Lie Lie Lie" and "Telling Myself" which have amassed over 30 million plus streams in a couple of months. His latest single "Feel Something" dropped May 7th.

He is also known for his recurring role as Aidan Peters on Disney Channel's "Stuck in the Middle." He recently guest starred on "Dirty John" and ABC's "Grey's Anatomy." An artist with Warner Records, Bassett unveiled his solo debut "Common Sense" in 2020. Within a month, it tallied 5 million total streams. Born in Oceanside, California, the 18 year-old actor, singer-songwriter and multi-talented musician started his career in theater and has landed nearly a dozen lead roles in local stage productions including Apostle James in "Godspell," The Cat in the Hat in "Seussical," Peter Pan in "Peter Pan," Kurt vonTrapp in "The Sound of Music" and Charlie in "Willy Wonka." In his downtime, Bassett enjoys writing music, playing his guitar and piano and watching as many films as possible.
