Jane Tranter Executive Producer

Award-winning television producer Jane Tranter is executive producer for the upcoming season of "Doctor Who," streaming Friday, May 10 on Disney+ where available.

Tranter is one of the industry's most respected and celebrated television executives.

A recipient of the BAFTA Special Award for her contribution to television, Tranter previously served as the BBC's Controller of Drama and subsequently Controller of Fiction before moving to Los Angeles to found production companies: BBC Worldwide Productions and Adjacent Productions for BBC Worldwide.

In 2015, she returned to the U.K. and, with Julie Gardner, founded the production company Bad Wolf in Cardiff with the purpose of creating ambitious, imaginative and relevant drama for the U.K., U.S. and global television markets. This marked the continuation of over 15 years of creative collaboration with the production and creative communities of Wales.

Tranter's credits for Bad Wolf include the multiple Emmy[®] Award-winning series "The Night Of," three seasons of the BAFTA Award-winning "His Dark Materials," three seasons of the critically acclaimed series "Industry," three seasons of the hugely popular "A Discovery of Witches" and two seasons of the BAFTA Award-winning "I Hate Suzie." Bad Wolf's television adaptation of Bernard Cornwell's "The Winter King" recently aired on ITVX and MGM+, and production is currently underway on season two of "Doctor Who" for Disney+ and BBC as well as "Dope Girls" for BBC.

In addition, Tranter was also an executive producer on the multiple award-winning series "Succession."
