Actress and singer JoMarie Payton reprises her role as Suga Mama in Disney+'s "The Proud Family: Louder and Prouder," the long-anticipated revival of the groundbreaking animated series "The Proud Family."

Best known for her role as Harriette on the hit series "Family Matters," Payton's additional television credits include "Perfect Strangers," "Will & Grace," "Moesha" and "The Proud Family," for which she earned three NAACP Image Award nominations and three NAMIC Vision Award nominations.
