Julian Lerner "Ray"

Julian Lerner stars as Ray, a comedic Daywalker and flatterer, in "ZOMBIES 4: Dawn of the Vampires," the latest installment in the Disney Channel Original Movie franchise.

Most recently, Lerner played Brad Hitman, the best friend of the lead character, Dean (Elisha Williams), in ABC's hit reboot "The Wonder Years." On stage, Lerner played The Artful Dodger in the 2023 New York City Center production of Lionel Bart's "Oliver!"

In 2022, Lerner wrapped filming for the fantasy-adventure film "Boys of Summer" alongside Mel Gibson. Directed by David Henrie, the film follows a trio of best friends (Lerner, Mason Thames, and Abby James Witherspoon) who team up with a retired detective (Gibson) to confront a supernatural entity that has recently moved to Martha's Vineyard.

Early in 2021, Lerner starred in the film "Yes Day" opposite Jennifer Garner, Edgar Ramirez, and Jenna Ortega, and was watched in nearly 53 million homes.

For the past three years, he has voiced Lucas in the animated series "Alma's Way." Additional credits include portraying the young Brian Cox in the podcast series "From Now," the comedy film "Pottersville," and the animated adaptation of the best-selling video game "Dragon Quest."

Other on stage credits include an out-of-town trial for a Broadway show in fall 2019 called "Last Days of Summer" as well as touring the country in the National Broadway Tour of "Les Misérables."

Lerner currently resides in New York.
