Liamani Segura stars as Sage in "Camp Rock 3."

Liamani is wise beyond her years. The 17-year-old singer-songwriter's dulcet, cascading vocals have earned her a record deal with Def Jam Recordings, a lead role on Disney's *High School Musical: The Musical: The Series*, and shout-outs from pop icons Mariah Carey and Justin Bieber. In 2025, she further introduced her artistry to the world with her debut EP *Dear Little Me*, a heartfelt and introspective project that draws from her personal journals, transforming her most meaningful entries into songs that highlight her emotional depth and storytelling ability.

Born and raised in Racine, Wisconsin, Segura comes from a rich cultural heritage—her father, an Army veteran, is Mexican, and her mother, a nurse, is Puerto Rican and Salvadorian. Surrounded by diverse musical influences, she taught herself to sing at a young age through YouTube, mastering contemporary pop ballads with striking emotional depth. At five, she performed "The Star-Spangled Banner" at a school talent show—her first viral moment—and that same ability to channel both sorrow and triumph continues to define her music today with poignancy and precision.

Building on her rising momentum, Segura is set to take on major roles within the Disney universe. She will star in the highly anticipated "Camp Rock 3" and appear in the fifth installment of the Descendants franchise, "Descendants: Wicked Wonderland," out this summer, further cementing her place as one of the most exciting young talents to watch. Segura will also tour arenas this fall with the "Worlds Collide Concert Tour" following her roles as "Sage" in "Camp Rock 3" and "Pink" in "Descendants: Wicked Wonderland."

"Camp Rock 3" premieres August 13 on Disney Channel and next day on Disney+.
