Their credits also include *I Spy*, *Charlie's Angels: Full Throttle*, *Bad Boys II*, *The Shaggy Dog*, *G-Force*, *National Treasure*, *National Treasure: Book of Secrets*, the television series "Common Law," and now "National Treasure: Edge of History" for Disney+.

The Wibberley's are currently writing feature films for Netflix (with Ice Cube) and Amazon (with Anne Hathaway).
