



## BIOGRAPHY JOHN RATZENBERGER

"Yeti/Bernard"

Emmy-nominated actor, screenwriter, producer and author John Ratzenberger voices the role of new character, Bernard, and reprises his role as Yeti, in Disney+'s "Monsters At Work," an original series inspired by the world of Disney and Pixar's Academy Award-winning "Monsters, Inc."

Ratzenberger is probably best-known for his starring role as lovable mail carrier Cliff Clavin in the beloved sitcom "Cheers." His other acting credits include "East Texas Miracle," "Change of Heart," "Superman," "Star Wars: Episode V – The Empire Strikes Back," "Legit" and Disney Channel's "Just Roll With It."

Well known for his voice acting work, Ratzenberger is featured in every Pixar film to-date, including the "Toy Story" films, the "Cars" films, "Wall-E," and "Ratatouille." In addition, his voice has been featured in "Pup Star: World Tour," "How Murry Saved Christmas" and several video games, such as "Kingdom Hearts III," "Lego the Incredibles," "Disney Magic Kingdoms" and "Disney Infinity."

Outside of acting, he has produced and hosted "Made in America," co-authored "We've Got it Made in America: A Common Man's Salute to an Uncommon Country" and created the "Nuts Bolts and Thingamajigs" foundation, which creates and funds manufacturing summer camps and scholarships nationwide by inspiring the next generation of inventors and entrepreneurs. He also developed the "ECOPACK," a biodegradable shipping material used to replace Styrofoam.

Ratzenberger enjoys sailing, fishing, playing billiards and performing music. He currently splits his time between residing in Connecticut and Southern California.
