Emmy Award-winning artist and director Paul Rudish is executive producer and supervising director for Disney's "The Wonderful World of Mickey Mouse," which spotlights Mickey and his best pals – Minnie, Donald, Daisy, Goofy and Pluto – as they embark on their greatest adventures yet, navigating the curveballs of a wild and zany world where the magic of Disney makes the impossible possible.

An animation veteran, Rudish also served as executive producer and supervising director of Disney Channel's Emmy and Annie Award-winning "Mickey Mouse" comedic cartoon shorts produced by Disney Television Animation. He also helped develop and direct hit series' "Dexter's Laboratory," "Samurai Jack," and "The Powerpuff Girls" for Cartoon Network. Previously, he served as art director on "Star Wars: Clone Wars" and was co-creator of "Sym-Bionic Titan."

Rudish's additional credits include development on "My Little Pony: Friendship Is Magic" and storyboarding Disney XD's "Tron: Uprising."

Rudish grew up on a small horse and goat farm in Raymore, Missouri. He was mentored and inspired by his father, Rich Rudish, an illustrator and director at Hallmark Cards in Kansas City, Missouri.

Rudish graduated from Cal Arts with a degree in Animation. He currently resides in Los Angeles, California.
