Joza made his stage debut at age 4 in his hometown of Durango, Colorado, playing Randy in the cult classic "A Christmas Story." His love for acting continued, and he went on to perform in many other local stage productions.

At age 11, Joza was the only actor under age 18 accepted into a prestigious Los Angeles Acting Workshop and subsequently started booking work in independent films and television. Joza starred as Spyder in Disney XD's sci-fi adventure comedy series, "MECH-X4."
