Pipe Bueno plays "Noah" in the original Disney+ series "It Was Always" Me Pipe is a singer and a composer who hails from Cali, Colombia. His interest in the popular music of his country led him to release his self-titled debut album in 2008, achieving national notoriety with songs like "Recostada en la cama" and "No voy a morir". In 2009, he won five Nuestra Tierra Awards for this work and was nominated for a Latin Grammy Award in the category of Best Band Music Album. Three years later, he released his second studio album –titled Infinito-and was called by Puerto Rican artists Jowell & Randy to remix the song Mi dama Colombiana alongside J Balvin and Pipe Calderón. Since then, he has released numerous hits, including "Te parece poco", "A primera vista"," Mala"," Esta vez te dejo", "Este amor no murió" and "Al son que me toquen bailo", with Johnny Rivera. In 2014, he released "La invitación" with Malumathe consolidating his national fame and conquering fans throughout Latin America. A year later, she collaborated with Wisin on the remix of the song "Corazón acelerado". Since then, Pipe has developed an extensive musical career with songs of his own authorship and collaborations with other internationally renowned artists. Recently, he met again with Maluma to launch "Tequila", the second artistic collaboration between the two that was released on March 25, 2021. His participation in "It Was Always Me" marks his acting debut.
