BLOOMING BRAIDED BARRETTE

The first step to acting the part is looking it. Practice Mulan's confidence by creating your very own hair clip to match her style.

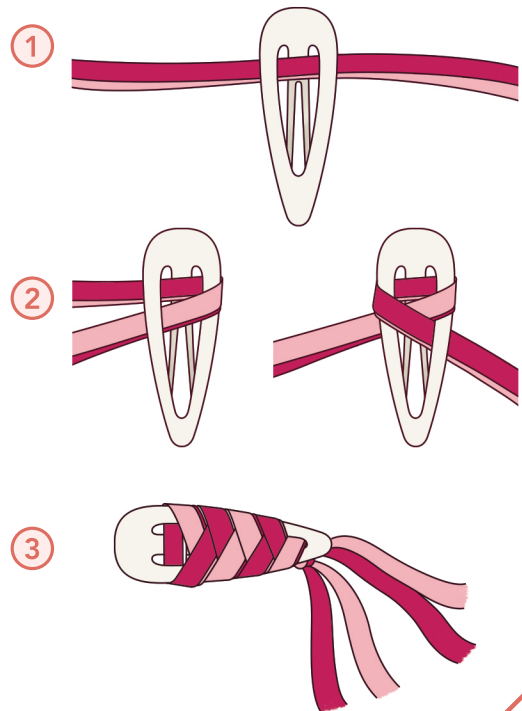
Supplies

- 2 of 3mm Red Ribbon (*About 1 metres of each ribbon, depending on how long you want the excess ribbon to be!*)
- Metal Snap Hair Clips

Directions

1. Open your clip and place it so the clip side is down and facing you. Take your two ribbons, lay one on top of the other, and thread them both through the top of the clip. Make sure they're even on both sides.
2. Take the ribbons on the right side and pass them around the clip edge and then through the top of the clip on the opposite side.
3. Keep weaving until you reach the end of the clip. When you're done, tie the ribbon ends into a tight knot at the bottom to hold everything in place.

Extra Activity! Find a flower to attach to the clip to really give it that Mulan look!





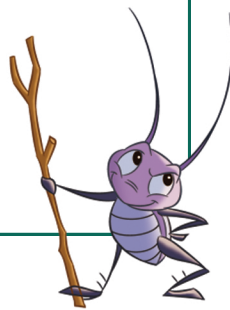

CRI-KEE ORIGAMI

The more Cri-kees the merrier! Create your own lucky cricket out of paper. Get ready to fold, press, and jump. Your paper Cri-kee can really hop!

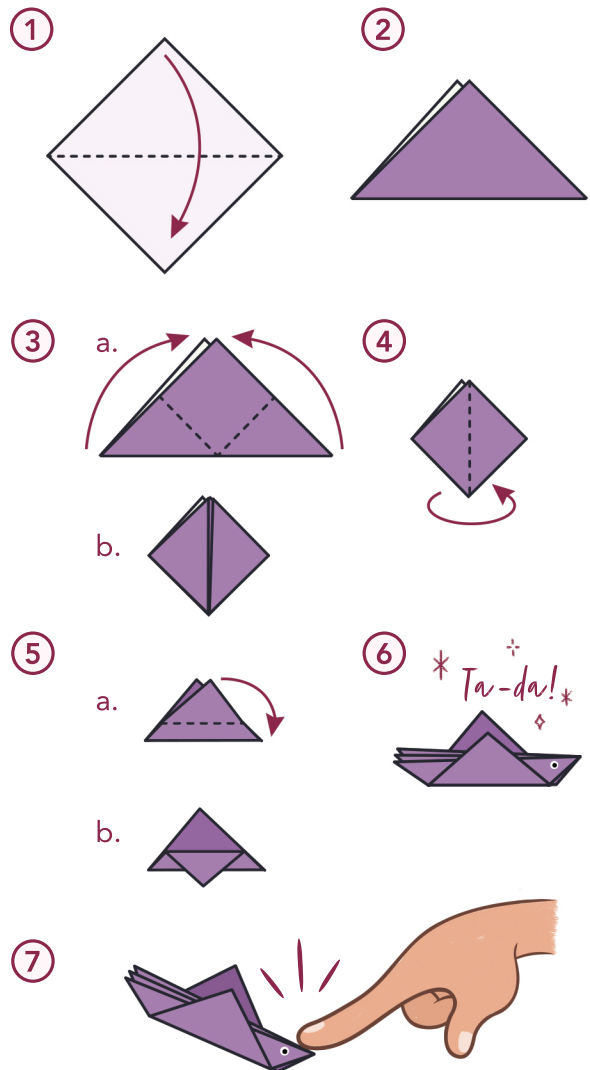
Supplies

- 3.5" Square Paper



Directions

1. Start with a square piece of paper (about 3.5 inches is perfect), with the colored side facing down.
2. Fold it in half diagonally to make a triangle. Press the fold nicely!
3. Take both pointy corners of the triangle and fold them up to the top point so the shape turns into a square.
4. Flip the square over and fold it in half along the open middle line.
5. Take just the top flap and fold it down about two-thirds of the way.
6. Fold the other side to match and your Cri-kee is complete!
7. Push down on the "nose" and watch your Cri-kee fly!



Tip! Try making a few in different colors and have a Cri-kee race with your friends!
