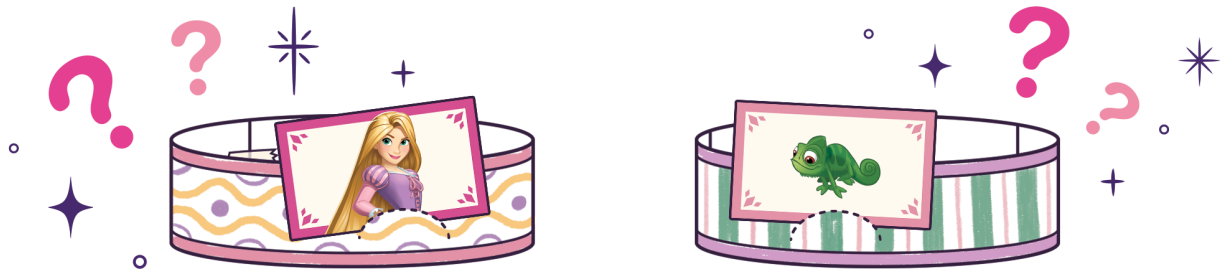


PRINCESS AND PALS Match Up

The princesses have lost their pals! Using only yes or no questions, try and figure out who you are to find your matching princess or pal!



Supplies

- Paper
- Scissors
- Tape

Game Directions

GROUP GAME

Step 1: Attach characters to each headband without kids seeing the character. Make sure all princesses and pals have their partner in play!

Step 2: Players ask yes/no questions to learn their identity. (Example: "Am I a fish?" "Do I sing in my movie?")

Step 3: Once players discover who they are, they find their matching pal/princess.

Step 4: After all matches are found, shuffle characters and play again.

DUO GAME

Step 1: Attach character to one headband without the player seeing it.

Step 2: Player with headband asks questions to determine their identity.


Step 3: Once identified, player finds their matching partner from cutouts on the table.

Step 4: Switch roles and use a new character for the next round.

HEADBAND TEMPLATE

1. Decorate and cut along the dotted line. Wrap the strips around the child's head and tape the ends together to create a perfectly fitting headband.
2.  This pocket is where you'll hold your princess character cards!
