1 = Unlikely: Injury/Near Miss should virtually never occur 2 = Possible: Injury/Near Miss may occur once during task 3 = Frequent: Injury/Near Miss may occasionally occur during task 4 = Highly Likely: Injury/Near Miss may occur several times during task 5 = Almost Certain: Injury/Near Miss almost certain to occur	 1 = No Injury: Minor Bump/Bruise, no First Aid Required, Report on Accident Form 2 = Minor: Administer Basic First Aid and Report on Accident Form 3 = Moderate: Serious Injury, Hospital Treatment (Not Life Threatening, No Overnight Stay) 4 = Major: Emergency Trip to Hospital and/or Overnight Stay 5 = Severe: Life Changing Injury, Hospitalisation for a period of 3 Days +, Death 			
	Risk Rating			

1 – 4 = Very Low: Risk adequately controlled. Inform staff of risk.

5 – 9 = Low: Risk adequately controlled. Inform staff of risk.

10–14 = Medium Activity may require further assessment to ascertain whether adequately controlled.

15-19 = RISK NOT ADEQUATELY CONTROLLED - REVIEW BEFORE CONTINUING

20-25 = UNACCEPTABLE RISK - DO NOT CONTINUE ACTIVITY
