Ariel Winter reprises her role as Princess Sofia in Disney Jr.'s "Sofia the First: Royal Magic," which follows Sofia as she attends The Charmswell School for Royal Magic, where she discovers she is the most magical princess in the EverRealm and must learn how to master her powers while making new royal friends.

Winter voiced Sofia in the original hit series, "Sofia the First," which debuted in 2012 and remains one of The Walt Disney Company's most successful global preschool franchises of all time.

Previously, she starred as Alex Dunphy, the intelligent youngest daughter of the Dunphy family, on ABC's multiple Emmy[®] and Golden Globe[®] Award-winning comedy series "Modern Family," for which she received multiple Screen Actors Guild Awards.

Her additional voiceover credits include "Horton Hears a Who!," "Mr. Peabody & Sherman," "Batman: The Dark Knight Returns" parts 1 and 2, "The Sisters Grimm," "Star Trek: Lower Decks" and the Emmy-winning animated series "Jake and the Never Land Pirates" and "Phineas and Ferb."

Winter began her acting career at the age of 4 and landed her first feature film role at the age of 7, starring opposite Val Kilmer, Robert Downey Jr. and Michelle Monaghan in director Shane Black's hit cult film "Kiss Kiss Bang Bang." Her additional film credits include "Don't Log Off," "Pools," "Like Father Like Son," "Tripped Up," "The Chaperone," "One Missed Call" and "Excision," an official selection to the 2012 Sundance Film Festival.
