***Executive Producer***

Tim Federle is the showrunner and executive producer of "High School Musical: the Musical: the Series," which he created for Disney+. The series recently won the Nickelodeon Kids' Choice Award for Favorite Kids' TV Show, and was renewed for a fourth season. Federle's novels include the *New York Times* Notable Book *Better Nate Than Ever* and its Lambda-winning sequel, which Lin-Manuel Miranda called "a wonderful evocation of what it's like to be a theater kid" (*New York Times*). A film adaptation of *Nate* — written and directed by Federle, and produced by Marc Platt and Adam Siegel — is now streaming on Disney+. He co-wrote the Broadway musical adaptation of *Tuck Everlasting*, and won the Humanitas Prize for co-writing the Golden Globe and Academy Award-nominated Best Animated Feature "Ferdinand," starring John Cena and Kate McKinnon.
