Eloise Mumford plays 'Trudy Cooper' in National Geographic's original scripted series THE RIGHT STUFF on Disney+, based on Tom Wolfe's bestselling nonfiction series, which dramatically explores the early days of the NASA space program.

A 2009 graduate of NYU Tisch School of the Arts, Eloise understudied Elisabeth Moss in "Speed the Plow" on Broadway while still in school, ultimately performing opposite William H. Macy and Raul Esparza. She made her TV debut as one of the female leads on Kyle Killen's FOX series "Lone Star" with Jimmy Wolk and Jon Voight.

Eloise played Dakota Johnson's best friend in all three of the Universal Pictures' "Fifty Shades of Grey" franchise films. In addition to recurring in the hit NBC series "Chicago Fire," she can be seen in the independent film "Standing Up, Falling Down" with Billy Crystal.
